## 1. Event Overview

- **Event Title:** Chinese Canadian Military Museum visitation
- **Date of Event:** July 17th, 2025
- **Location:** 555 Columbia St, Vancouver, BC V6A 4H5
- **Organizing Team:** "YES" Surrey youth group II

## 2. Purpose & Objectives

This visit focuses on the often-overlooked contributions of Chinese Canadians who served in both World War I and World War II. Despite lacking full citizenship rights, many chose to serve Canada, helping to pave the way for greater equality.

Transportation was a concern. Without the bus, attendance would have been much lower. It was a last minute solution but worked out well.

### • Suggested improvements for future events

Include more interactive elements with the audience, to make the experience more engaging.
